POST-EVENT REPORT 2018



Foreword

Solar & Storage Finance Texas was developed based on overwhelming feedback from our Clients that the ERCOT market for projects was hotting up - and it delivered!

A high-level audience of utilities, developers, installers, funds, banks, equity investors and suppliers met in April 2018 to chart a path for stronger relationships moving forward.

Attendees flew from around the USA to meet in Houston and discussions focused on:


- The main macros and headwinds in the US market: happening close to the Section 201 decision, as well as the decision to apply tariffs to steel imported into the country, attendees were keen to discuss the impact on project economics. Moreover, the keynote panel discussed the impact of the current administration on the solar and storage industry but concluded that the C&I market, as well as keen interest in investment opportunities in clean energy would drive the market forward.
- The evolution of debt for storage and storage technologies: there was a scintillating discussion around how debt providers are evolving their offerings given the maturation of energy storage. Audience members had questions around the length of warranties for lithium-ion batteries, how long the batteries could really be expected to last in operation and how lithium stacks up against other technologies. 33% of respondents to our on-site poll are tracking flow batteries and the same number are tracking thermal. 22% were interested in compressed air.
- Secondary markets and M&A: as one of the hottest debates on-site, we looked into current activities in secondary markers across the country. With speakers from several prominent funds, we heard from them about what they were looking for in terms of their acquisition strategy. We also asked whether attendees thought current projects were over- or under-valued.

Many more topics were discussed across the 2-day event but I was especially pleased to work with WRISE to look at how we encourage more women into our industry. Our keynote panel on this was exceptionally candid and we thank them, along with all of our speakers, sponsors and supporters for the hard work they put into making this event such a success.




