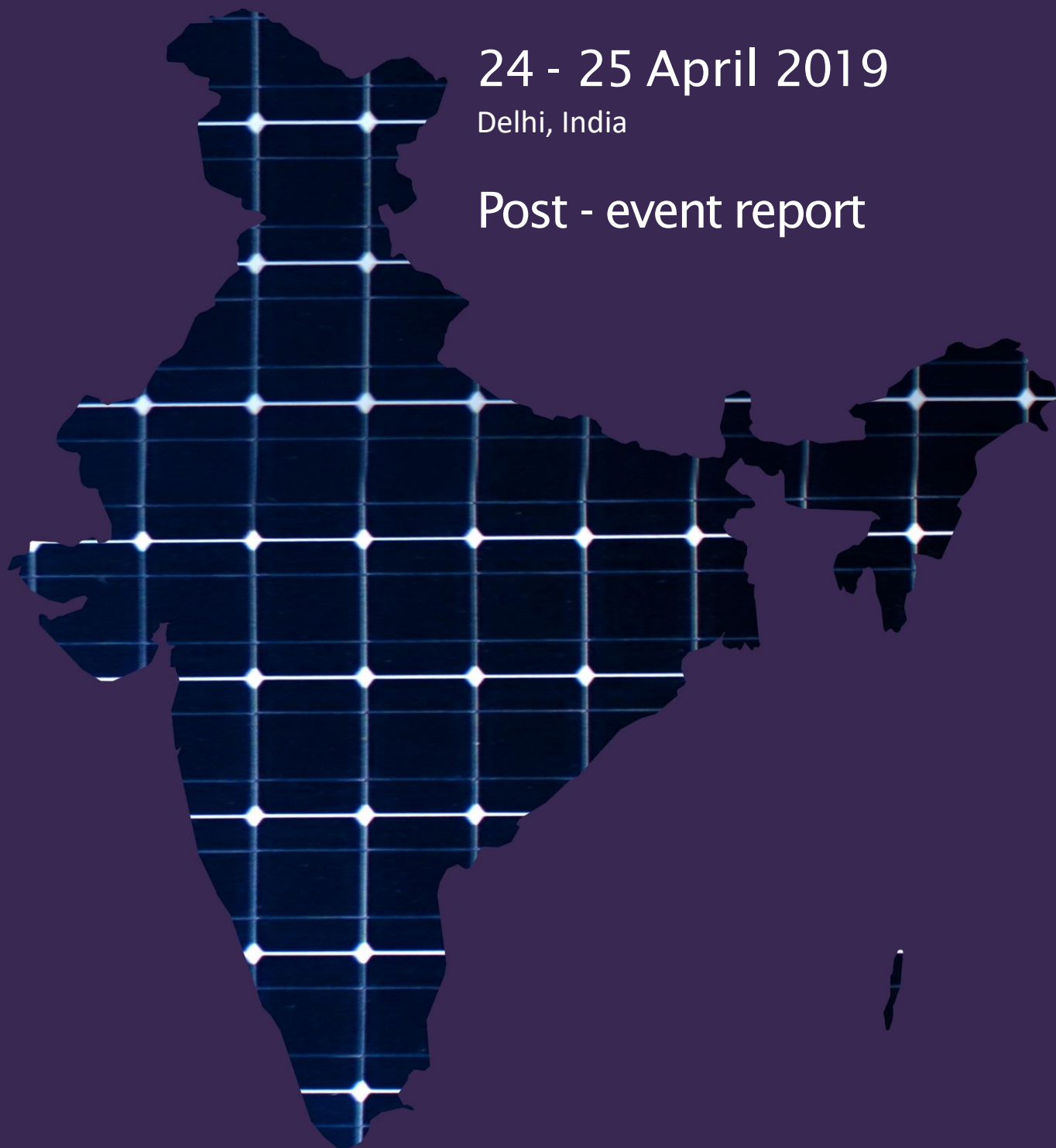

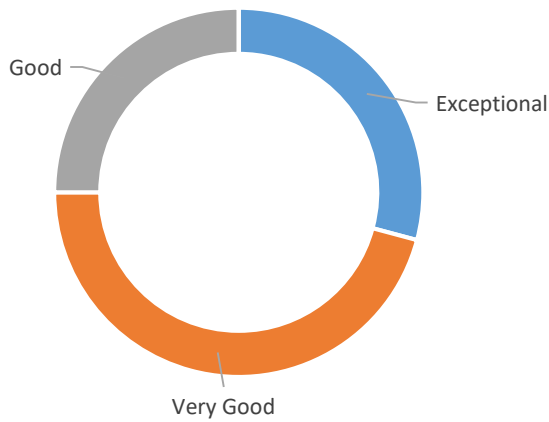

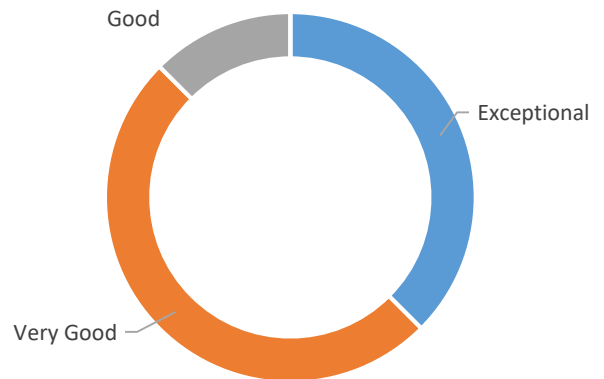

How would you rate the conference for the networking on-site?

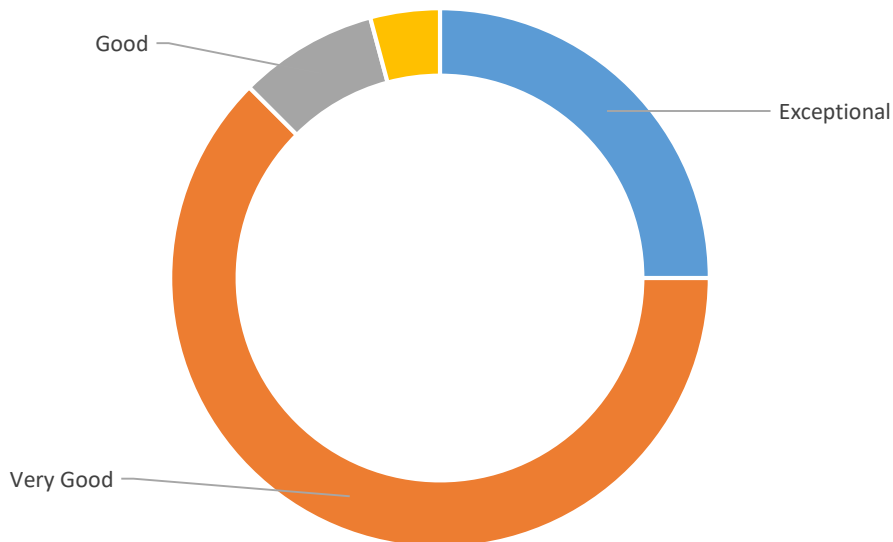

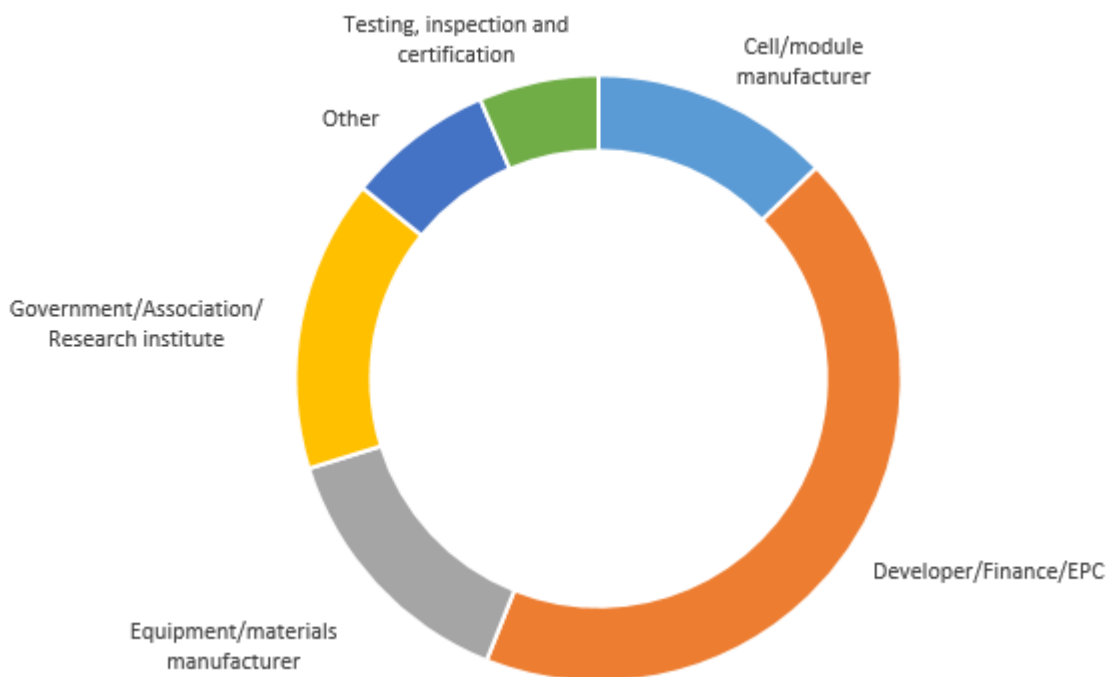
